### PENALTY FEES

\$5 penalty fee per entry for incomplete/incorrect information on entry forms.

\$20 penalty fee per entry for class changes to any entry after December 20<sup>th</sup>.

### PIANO RULES

1. In order to be eligible to win Division Championship Trophies and Piano Most Promising Trophies & Bursaries, a contestant must have performed in at least two (2) solo classes within a given division, one (1) of which may be a Concert Group class.
2. Championship trophies may be withheld if, in the Adjudicator's opinion, no performance measures up to championship caliber. A competitor will be limited to three (3) successive wins of the Grand Championship.
3. At the Piano Playoffs, trophy winners will be chosen and the decision of the adjudicator will be final. To be eligible for an award, a competitor must perform at the Piano Playoffs.
4. Participants may not compete in more than one Division. Students may enter in no more than two (2) consecutive grades within any one Division except in Concert Group. If a participant wishes to play in two Divisions, he/she will have to enter as "Non-Competitive" in one of the Divisions. A participant may not enter more than six (6) solo classes in a division.
5. ARCT Classes: Limit 3 years and Open Classes ARCT beyond 3 years or Licentiate.
6. In the Junior Piano Solo Division, Lower Intermediate Piano Solo Division, Upper Intermediate Piano Solo Division and Senior Piano Solo Division the age limit will be 28.
7. The older beginner Piano Solo Classes are open to Amateurs ages 10 to 18. Two Classes, # **1805** - one solo any style and one Concert Group #**1806** (two or three pieces) only covering Grades 1 to 6. *Found in Lower Intermediate.*
8. The Adult Piano Solo Division is open to Amateur adults 19 and over. (changed 2023)

### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS FOR PIANO

#### INTRODUCTORY CLASS - CLASS 0100 (see change Music Selection submissions for this class only)

An introductory, non-competitive class with TWO (2) contrasting selections from Suzuki Book I; Royal Conservatory of Music Celebration Series, The Piano Odyssey, Introductory Grade Repertoire; or Conservatory Canada, The New Millennium Series, Pre-Grade I.

*(These are the only acceptable Editions for this Class)*

No marks are given, and all participants receive a friendly adjudication and a certificate of accomplishments. Students in this class may not be entered in any other Piano solo class.

Music Selections may be 'TBA' but must be submitted by January 10<sup>th</sup> by 'Google Form.'

#### BAROQUE MUSIC - CLASSES 0101-0115

Music of the Baroque period (approximately 1600-1750) as represented by the music of Telemann, Scarlatti, J.S. Bach (**Grade 1 to 6**), Handel, Rameau, Couperin, etc.

### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS FOR PIANO (cont'd)

#### J.S. BACH - CLASSES 0207-0215

Music written by J.S. Bach (1685-1750)

#### CLASSICAL MUSIC - CLASSES 0301-0315

Music of the Classical period (1750-1825) as represented by the music of Mozart, Haydn, Beethoven, Kuhlau, Clementi, Dussek, etc. Please state key, opus number and movement, if applicable, on the Entry Form.

#### SONATAS: MOZART/HAYDN/SCHUBERT - CLASSES 0410A-0415B

For Grade 10 and ARCT, performer may choose to perform two substantial contrasting movements (**A**) or three movements (**B**). Please choose fee accordingly.

#### BEETHOVEN - CLASSES 0510A-0515B

For Grade 10 and ARCT, performer may choose to perform two substantial contrasting movements (**A**) or three movements (**B**). Please choose fee accordingly.

#### ROMANTIC MUSIC - CLASSES 0601-0615

Music of the Romantic period (1825-1900) written by composers such as Brahms, Grieg, Fauré, Schumann, Mendelssohn, Schubert, etc., EXCLUDING Chopin - Grades 9 to ARCT. Please note that in the Senior Division, Schubert Sonatas are to be played in the Sonata Class (Haydn/Mozart/Schubert).

#### POST-ROMANTIC MUSIC - CLASSES 0707-0715

Music of the Post-Romantic period (List D in RCM syllabus other than French) written by composers such as Rachmaninoff, Sibelius, Granados, Scriabin, etc.

#### CHOPIN - CLASSES 0810-0815

Music written by Chopin.

#### IMPRESSIONISTIC COMPOSERS - CLASSES 0907-0915

Music by French composers such as Debussy and Ravel.

#### 20<sup>TH</sup> & 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY MUSIC - CLASSES 1001-1015

Music of the 20th Century, by composers born after 1865 as represented by the music of Bartók, Stravinsky, Khatchaturian, Kabalevsky, Satie, etc. Own selection other than Contemporary works, see CONTEMPORARY STYLES - CLASSES 1301-1315

#### CANADIAN COMPOSERS - CLASSES 1101-1115

Music by Canadian composers such as Archer, Bayley, Beckwith, Berlin, Buczynski, Coulthard, Dolin, Ethridge, Fiala, Fleming, Hansen, Marsden, Melecci, Peterson, Poole, etc. Own selection.

#### CONCERT GROUP - CLASSES 1201-1215

Three pieces chosen from various periods, styles and moods. In *Adult Piano Solo Division and Late Beginners in Lower Intermediate Piano Solo* may perform two or three pieces from various periods, styles and moods. No composer to be used more than once. Selections from any grades within one division may be used.

#### CONTEMPORARY STYLES - CLASSES 1301-1315

Pop, Gospel, Jazz, and popular and abridged transcriptions (e.g. Pachelbel's Canon) of "Classical" music.

#### TEACHER'S CHOICE - CLASSES 1401-1410

Students in levels 1-10 and ARCT may enter a repertoire selection or one etude from current syllabus or not listed in any current piano syllabus. If not listed in any current syllabus, selection must be comparable length and difficulty to other selections in that level.

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS FOR PIANO (cont'd)

### ENSEMBLE CLASSES – DUETS & TRIOS for PIANO - CLASSES 1501-1515

In Ensemble Classes, grades from any division may be combined. Selection is to be entered in the grade level of the piece, not the performers.

### SIGHT READING - CLASSES 1601-1615 (NOT AVAILABLE 2022)

Test Pieces are chosen by the Adjudicator following requirements set out in the Royal Conservatory of Music Examination Syllabus.

### OWN COMPOSITION - CLASSES 1000

For Solo instrument, vocal, instruments with piano accompaniment or any combination of chamber instruments. A copy of the composition MUST be received by the Festival Registrar by February 1<sup>st</sup> in order to mail to the adjudicator for perusal. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** More than one entry per contestant is allowed as long as they represent different disciplines.
