NOTE: Any studio/teacher overages under \$50 will be given out in bursary funds by festival in the same year.

PENALTY FEES

\$5 penalty fee per entry for incomplete/incorrect information on entry forms.

\$20 penalty fee per entry for class changes to any entry after December 20th.

TROPHIES & SHIELD RETURNS

Shields and Trophies are the property of the Chilliwack Music and Dance Festival and are to be competed for annually. Please have your shields and trophies engraved early. Winners MUST return trophies in the same condition as presented, so please clean, polish and repair before returning.

ALL SHIELDS AND TROPHIES WON IN 2022 MUST BE RETURNED BY DECEMBER 1, 2022.

If not returned by December 15th, 2022 there will be a \$25 penalty charged. If not returned by January 1st, 2023, participants will not be eligible to perform in the current year's festival.

WOODWINDS - BRASS - PERCUSSION RULES

- No class winner is eligible to enter final competition with a mark less than 86. To be recommended, by the Adjudicator, to the Provincial competitions, a competitor must achieve a mark of 85 or over. In order to be considered for BC Provincials, a competitor must compete in at least two (2) solo classes within a given Grade Division.
- Championships may be withheld if no performance measures up to the championship caliber in the Adjudicator's opinion.
- A student may enter any class on a competitive or non-competitive basis. Non-competitive students will receive a written adjudication only, and they will not be considered for placement or awards. All fee structures and regulations apply. **Please mark on Entry Form if non-competitive.**
- In Ensemble Classes Only: If time limit will allow, 2 contrasting pieces may be played.
- RCM 2003 Brass Syllabus, RCM 2005 Percussion Syllabus, RCM 2006 / 2010 / 2014 Woodwind Syllabus and RCM 2008 Recorder Syllabus are to be used as a Guide to appropriately Graded Music Selections for all instruments.
- Participants may not compete in more than one division. A participant may not enter more than four (4) solo classes in a division.
- New 2016.** In this Division only, a participant may enter 2 entries in the same class if they are from two (2) contrasting eras of music. I.e, one Baroque & one Classical; one Romantic & one 20th Century; one Concerto & one Sonata

Music written prior to 1825. Transcriptions may be used when originally written for other instruments. Please state composer and arranger of said transcription. Grades 6 and up, DO NOT include Sonatas / Concertos. SEE SONATAS / CONCERTOS for correct placement.

ROMANTIC / 20TH AND 21ST CENTURY

Music written after 1800. Transcriptions may be used when originally written for other instruments. Please state composer and arranger of said transcription. Grades 6 and up, DO NOT include Sonatas / Concertos. SEE SONATAS / CONCERTOS for correct placement.

SONATAS / CONCERTOS (2 contrasting movements maximum)

Grade 6 to ARCT only. Selection may be two contrasting movements from any Sonata or Concerto. Transcriptions may be used when originally written for other instruments. Please state composer and arranger of said transcription.
